Chairman Lonnie Peters opened the Board of Equalization meeting. Roll call was answered by Lonnie Peters, Chairman and Commissioners Caleb Johnson, Kim Elder and Toney Krajewski. Commissioner C.W. Baltzell was absent. Also attending the meeting were County Clerk Sandra Olson, County Assessor Renae Zink and County Attorney Randy Fair. Elder moved to approve the agenda, Johnson seconded the motion. Krajewski, Johnson, Elder and Peters voting aye, Baltzell absent; none voting nay; motion carried. Commissioner Baltzell entered the meeting. Krajewski moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting, Johnson seconded the motion. Elder, Baltzell, Johnson, Krajewski and Peters voting aye; none voting nay; motion carried.

Zink spoke to the Board regarding the Morse valuation. Zink told the Board the attorney from Property Assessment and Taxation she had spoken with had said the Board could not have another hearing on a property they had already made a decision on even though the person who protested it was not the property owner. County Attorney Randy Fair stated there was a lawsuit pending on this property and no action was needed at this time.

Zink presented the Board with tax roll corrections. Krajewski moved to authorize Chairman Peters to sign and date the tax roll corrections, Elder seconded the motion. Baltzell, Johnson, Elder, Krajewski and Peters voting aye; none voting nay; motion carried.
